When Saul and I came to Ithaca in 1976, Bob Cofer was already a fixture at the Bridge Club of Ithaca. As far back as I can remember, Bob was at every game, studying the ins and outs of every hand.

No one that I ever met was as serious as Bob about bridge. At every game he recorded each hand and analyzed it afterwards. There seldom was a time that we would arrive at the club, when Bob wouldn't come up to us and say "Do you remember that hand where....?" He would then share his thoughts on the hand, and discuss at length additional insights that he had gleaned from his painstaking analysis.

There was a time that I went to Bob's house to look up something in old Bulletins that he kept in his study. I was amazed, as I went through his Bulletins, at the notes that he had written in the margins of every article, the tips and nuggets that he had underlined, providing a record of his life in bridge. I had tremendous respect for his bridge scholarship.

There isn't a bridge player in Upstate New York who didn't have at least one run-in with Bob's crazy bidding system. He loved and nurtured this system, inflicting it upon his regular partners, and causing more than one brouhaha at tournaments. He believed deeply in the merits of the system and he nurtured it over the years as one would a child. As far as I can see, this system was just one more manifestation of Bob's dedication to the game and its infinite possibilities.

I will miss Bob at our tournaments. Quietly-spoken, and a consummate gentleman at all times, he had a smile and a cheery word for everyone. To my mind, he represented the best in bridge. He was an original, no one was quite like him. Bye bye Bob. I hope that you found someone up there to play your system.

### ***Interesting Bridge Hand***

(submitted by Paul Cherin, Rochester)

Perhaps seeking ruffs is not the best way to defend. This hand occurred at a recent club game.

Everybody vulnerable  
The bidding proceeds as follows  
(South is dealer):

1H	1S	2C*	2S**
3H	3S	all pass	

\*A negative free bid

\*\*I don't understand this bid either

The opening lead was the 6C to the A. At this point the contract cannot be beaten. The QH is returned and ruffed by N, who is basically ruffing a loser with a winner. In an attempt to get another ruff, N returns the 3D to the Q and A. West has no choice but to lay down the AS catching the KS and then the JS with the Q, making 4.

Had N started with the JS, it would have gone Q, K, A. Had they never played D, the hand would have been down 1.

### ***Letter To the Editor***

If every experienced duplicate bridge player would take a new player on as a student, our game would prosper, and certainly I wish this as much as anyone.

But I would like to note the following:

Duplicate bridge sanctioned by the ACBL has a set of rules. Not to follow these rules destroys the integrity of the game. Newer players should be instructed in these rules starting very early on. In particular, there are rules about unauthorized information being conveyed by hesitations and by extraneous comments. The rules also require partners to have two identically filled out convention cards available to the opponents. Duplicate bridge is a timed event, and slow play (and even some experienced players in the Rochester area are inconsiderate in this aspect of the game too!!) should NOT be tolerated by the club directors, even if the offending player is a relative beginner.

To illustrate one of these points: recently, I was declarer in a touchy contract playing against two opponents who did NOT have a properly made out set of convention cards. I received the lead of the 8 of a suit. I could see the ace, the queen, and the ten. So is the eight the "top of nothing" or fourth best? With not much to go on, I made the wrong guess, and went down.

For some time now I have been playing two or three times a month with a relatively inexperienced player. When we started playing he had less than 50 masterpoints. Right or wrong, I have lectured him extensively on proper tempo, extraneous comments, and conventional agreements that we have. I am proud to report that at the recent National in St. Louis, he and I were first in "B" in a FAST PAIR (!) event, and were awarded a little over 5 gold points.

Sure, let's encourage new players. We need them! But let us also try to get them to play by the rules from the beginning. Not to do so is, I believe, a disservice to all of us.

### ***Information on the North American Pairs***

- \*Club qualifying games 50/50 red and black at sectional rating
- \*One-session unit qualifying games sectional rated red
- \*Two-session unit qualifying games include percentage of gold for overalls.
- \*District finals award gold for section firsts and overalls. Flight C is 25% gold for overalls. Other masterpoints in all flights are red.

Flights: A (Open), B (-2000), C (0-500 Non-Life Masters)  
Final: Spring 2008 NABC

The North American Pairs (NAP) is a highly prestigious "grass roots" event which starts at the club level with qualifying sessions in June, July and August. Club-level qualifications may be earned at any club in any unit in any district. A player may qualify as often as desired and with as many different partners as desired. Unit-level qualifiers are optional and held after September 1 and before the district final, which may be held after the unit final until the third week in January. At the district final, both players must have qualified at the club level and must be members of the parent district. A fixed amount prize will be awarded in all flights as follows:

1. In districts with three qualifiers, the 1st place qualifiers will receive \$700 per person and the 2nd place qualifiers will receive \$300 per person. The 3rd place qualifiers will be invited to participate in the national level finals, but will not receive any prize.
2. In districts with four qualifiers, the 1st and 2nd place qualifiers will receive \$700 per person and the 3rd place qualifiers will receive \$300 per person. The 4th place qualifiers will be invited to participate in the national level finals, but will not receive any prize.
3. Invited defenders will receive \$700 per person.
4. No individual may collect two concurrent prizes.

The monetary award will be available on site. Qualifiers must play in the national level event until eliminated to receive the award. *There will be no entry fee for the national level of the event.* Check with your district to learn whether it provides additional funding. Some districts provide additional funding.

***From your District President Lois Sanders:*** In Flight C, if District 4 is one of the top four districts in the country on table count, we will be able to send two 1st place winners. Let's get out there and support this event.
