## *A Few Thoughts from an "A" Player*

Our very own Margie Spence, a member of the RABA Board of Directors, has published two charming commentaries in which she admits to being "an 'A' player wanna be". In this article I will try to provide some insight into the views and attitudes of an "A" player.

Margie is so right when she notes that all players were once novices. Looking back at some relatively good tournament results from this perspective, I wonder how I and my partners ever achieved such results when I knew even less than I do today! For example, one day at a Rochester Regional some 15 years ago, my partner and I were first overall in "C", first in "B", and second in "A" only to Howard Piltch (a former president of the ACBL) and his client! For my partner (Judy Bailey), it was her first ever gold points. What a wonderful memory!

"It's only a game!" "No, it isn't; it's life!"

Duplicate bridge provides opportunities to feel many emotions, and in my experience the more involved you get, the broader these emotions will be. More so than with less advanced players, "A" players sometimes find it difficult to contain their emotions, especially if a hand yields a result they are unhappy with. More than a few "A" players are very good bridge players, but not-so-good partners because they are trying so hard to do well, and if partner causes them not to do well, they sometimes take their frustrations out on partner: call the director!! Thank you Margie for this correct advice!

Until one attains the heights of the "super players", there is still a great deal that all players can learn. For example, despite almost 70 years of playing bridge, I have never executed a Vienna coup, a well known play. Nor has one ever been executed against me (as far as I know!). But I think I might be able to recognize the need to do so should the appropriate hand come up: I can hardly wait!

I would urge all players to read the rules of duplicate bridge. Competent players need to know the rules, at least most of them, even if the director is called to arbitrate an irregularity. Even national tournament directors can occasionally fail to give a correct ruling, so a player sometimes needs protection even from a director! Knowing the rules will assist all players in avoiding director calls for such irregularities as unauthorized information conveyed by hesitations, etc.

Successful duplicate bridge requires some effort to have agreements with partner. Perhaps someone like Zia can play with another star for the first time, and win a high level tournament, but the rest of us need to have discussions with our partners to have much success. Waiting for all the situations to come up and to discuss them later is no where nearly as good as having detailed discussions with partner while making out duplicate convention cards which ACBL rules require be available to your opponents.

If you have not played in an NABC (national) duplicate bridge tournament, I suggest that you try to get your favorite partner to go to one or more. This exposure will definitely add to your overall bridge experience to your benefit if your ambition is to become an "A" player. If a national is a bit too much (and they are not cheap), at least try a regional or two.

There are about 158,000 members of ACBL. The average member has about 240 masterpoints. One of many great things about our game is that the average player can compete - sometimes even successfully! - against the top professionals. So far I have played competitively against 15 of the top 200 masterpoint holders in the ACBL. What a privilege!
