A Tribute : Dan Boye Achieves Platinum Life Master

Dan Boye began playing while a student-athlete at Syracuse University. As most of us back in those days, he started playing rubber bridge, and then discovered duplicate. There was a definite connection as he took to the game immediately. He very shortly afterwards broke onto the tournament schedule and made an immediate impact.

As time went along, he progressed to the highest levels of Unit 112. Since then he has won all of our trophies multiple times and has won countless sectional and regional events. He has also had several overall finishes in National events.

This past year Dan reached a great milestone as he went over 10,000 Master points and became only the second member of Unit 112 to accomplish this feat. His accomplishment is especially impressive since Dan has never been on the “circuit” traveling the country to accumulate points. During all these years, Dan has had a full time job in various aspects of the insurance industry, and has played when time and family circumstances has allowed. In addition, along the way he has always taken time to play with some of the newer players.

While he is a gifted technical player, one of his primary assets is his “table feel”. This is a rather nebulous term, but generally means he has a sense of what is going on above and beyond the actual cards that ar played. Players with his talent often make the “wrong” plays at the right time. As a partner of Dan for many years, I have seen many a time that he pulls the proverbial rabbit out of the hat.

Once again, congratulations and good luck on starting the next 10,000 points.
