

**President's Message:**

Our mission to the Unit 112 bridge player is to preserve and promote the best interests of and to stimulate interest in the art of playing competitive, duplicate contract bridge. The following represents our thoughts on implementing that goal in 2009.

Unit 112 - Committee Meeting - 3/14/09

**Present:** Mary Miller, Walt Gable, Laura Krauss, Lois Sanders, Mike Mihevc, Debbie Suller

**Purpose:** Develop plan to increase attendance at sectional tournaments

1. Encourage playing areas to provide a variety of food at sectionals:
  - a. Playing area can buy ingredients (e.g. mixes) and ask members to prepare the food;
  - b. Solicit donations from local businesses; or
  - c. Ask members to contribute items.
2. Use of the internet
  - a. Improve/expand use of the Unit 112 distribution list. (Have a written form to use at clubs that members can sign, agreeing that their name would be added to the Unit 112 distribution list.)
  - b. Post written procedures on the Unit 112 website regarding how to have tournament information posted on the ACBL website and how to have the ACBL send out an email regarding an upcoming tournament.
3. Hold a Unit 112 Charity tournament - it's important to choose the charity ahead of time and do the planning and promotion of the tournament around the specific charity. To attract the social players, especially the ones who support the local charity. We would have to permit increased entry fees to make the contribution.
4. New Players:
  - a. Hold a side "social game" (could be non-sanctioned) at the sectionals and invite local social bridge groups;
  - b. Hold "chalk talks";
  - c. Encourage playing areas to hold separate sections (e.g. 99er or 199er or 299er) and do specific advertising with bridge teachers and club managers across the unit;
  - d. Need to have a plan for each tournament on how to welcome the newer players and to work with the group;
  - e. Provide name tags;
  - f. Provide prizes;
  - g. Develop a "new players section" on the Unit website;
  - h. Share information regarding the ACBL cooperative advertising program with playing areas advertising
5. Unit Board Members:
  - a. Wear name tags to all sectionals;
  - b. Publicize unit activities at clubs and sectionals;
  - c. Provide information to clubs on what to publicize;
  - d. Develop a Unit 112 brochure;
  - e. Encourage each playing area to conduct a similar "planning/brainstorming" session to increase attendance at clubs;
  - f. Move Unit board meetings around the Unit.
6. Tournaments flyers:
  - a. Make them more attractive (use of graphics);
  - b. Recommend that the Unit would reimburse playing areas for advertising
7. Encourage car pooling to tournaments.
8. Offer free plays for teachers who bring students to sectionals.
9. Survey members about what motivates them to go to tournaments.
10. Look at consistence of starting times.
11. Offer mini-lessons before sectionals.
12. Give out unit recognition awards at different sites.
13. Make the webmaster a member of the Unit board.
14. Have a sign or flyer at each sectional with information about upcoming Unit 112 tournaments (when/where).
